<u>Description</u>: Anti-VEGF Neutralizing Recombinant Human antibody. This antibody has not been tested for cross-reactivity with other species.

<u>Purification</u>: Protein A affinity purification from HEK293 supernatants.

Application: VEGF is a cell surface protein which signals for the growth of blood vessels. Anti-VEGF monoclonal antibodies are used to block tumor angiogenesis.

Specific Activity




Fig.1 The Anti-VEGF Antibody was evaluated using KDR-NFAT-Luc (HEK293) Cell Line (BPS# 79387). VEGF165 (10 ng/ml at final concentration) was incubated with various concentrations of Anti-VEGF Antibody in the assay medium (DMEM + 1% BSA) for 45 min at room temperature and added to the cells. After 4 hour incubation at 37°C under 5% CO2, ONE-Step Luciferase Assay System (BPS# 60690) was used to measure the luciferase activity.

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
